# Seeing beyond

### **Preparatory steps**



Verify the lens is centered and secure in the IOL chamber.




Cover the whole lens and blue plunger tip with a **generous** amount of OVD. Avoid touching the lens and blue plunger tip.

Close the lid of the IOL chamber.

**IMPORTANT:** Allow the lens to remain in this position until the surgeon is ready to implant it into the eye.

### Implantation steps




Advance the lens to the intermediate position. Gently press the plunger forward until an audible 'click' is heard.

**IMPORTANT:** The lens should be implanted immediately.



Injection: Ensure that loading chamber wings are facing upwards.



Slowly advance the lens until it has been released from the injector. If delivery is incomplete, apply additional force to the thumb flange to release the lens. **Assistance feature:** The ramp stop at the back of the injector helps control excess travel of the plunger at the end of IOL delivery.



Carefully position the lens in the capsular bag.
